Obituary for Mrs Cecil Davis Robinson

Cecil Davis Robinson, age 93, passed away Friday, May 5, 2017 at the residence of her son.

Mrs. Robinson was born June 6, 1923 in Conway, SC, a daughter of the late Oma Benjamin and Alberta Skipper Lewis. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her first and second husbands, Samuel Earl Davis and Colonel Charles H.
