



Charles Attilio Torcellini

April 4, 1929 - August 8, 2016

Charles Attilio Torcellini passed away peacefully at the age of 87 on August 8, 2016 in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina.

He leaves his loving wife of 66 years, Concetta (Urso) Torcellini; his daughter Cynthia and her husband Anthony Cucchiaro; his daughter Carolyn and her husband John Geer; and his grandson, Jack Geer.

Born April 4, 1929 in New Haven, Connecticut, the son of Attilio Torcellini and Adria (Seidenari) Torcellini, he was the sixth child of seven and is survived by three brothers: James, Joseph and Paul Torcellini. His brother Henry and sisters, Anna Bentley and Eleanor Ozinsky, predeceased him.

After graduating from St. Mary's Academy in New Haven, he attended the University of Connecticut. He served aboard the USS Wisconsin during the Korean War, and later for two years in Malta. Mr. Torcellini enjoyed his memberships at the Marchegian Club in New Haven and the American Legion (Post 127) in Orange. In retirement, he enjoyed playing golf and developing his many personal renovation projects. He was a devoted husband and loving father and grandfather. He cherished his family
