Mr. Charles Coates Wade, Sr., 79, husband of Sue Nelle Bryan Wade, passed away Wednesday, June 28, 2017 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center, entering the Kingdom of Heaven the way he lived, on God's terms, while surrounded by family.

Born June 20, 1938 in Florence, SC, Mr. Wade was the son of the late Jesse Linwood Wade, Sr. and the late Ruth Stanley Wade. Charlie spent his life in service to others. He served his community as a friend and as a mentor, always being there for those in need of a helping hand. He served his country as a captain in the U. S. Army during the Vietnam era.
