Dorothy Louise Saunders Chinery age 88, of Suffolk, Virginia (formerly residing in Woodlake

After graduation she was employed as a Dietician at Muhlenburg Hospital in Plainfield, New

Dorothy married Frank Chinery in 1948 and a year later began devoting herself to raising the
