Cleo McElwin Miles (known as Elwin), died October 22, at MUSC Hospital in Florence, SC. He was 73 years old. He was born on July 19, 1951, in Florence, SC. Elwin was a graduate of J.C. Lynch High School and Francis Marion University, where he received a Business Administration degree. He started his career at JC Penney's in management. He published three books of faith, taught his Sunday school group, and sang in a Gospel Quartet in his past. He was always looking for ways to help others in need and for the past twelve years organized the Carolina Forest Food drive twice a year. He inspired others to make a difference. True integrity, compassion and endless pursuit of righteousness defined his daily ambition. His legacy would be faith, family and friendsdefinitely his daily goal.
