



## Kenneth Samuel Holt

Kenneth Samuel Holt, age 84, passed away at Anderson Oaks in Conway, SC after suffering with Alzheimer's for many years.

His deep dedication to God led him to serve the church in many leadership roles, but the one he loved the best was being Head Usher. He loved to greet people and welcome them to God's house. Mr. Holt was an active member of many civic organizations including: Conway Kiwanis Club for 60 years, a Mason and a Shriner. He also served on the Advisory Board of Santee Cooper for 20 years.
