Mr. Soucy was born in Hyannis, Mass., a son of the late Alcibiade and Almena Rogers Soucy. He enlisted in the US Air Force where he proudly served his country for exactly 22 yrs. 3 mos. and 19 days. He was a proud veteran of the Korean and Vietnam wars.
