



Richard Cornfoot

May 7, 1930 - May 20, 2018

Richard Cornfoot passed away on May 20, 2018. Born in Revere, Massachusetts, he was the son of the late David and Ruth Cornfoot. In addition to his parents, Mr. Cornfoot is predeceased by his son, Allan David Cornfoot.

He attended the University of Massachusetts where as a backstroker he was the first athlete in school history to earn his letter 3 years in a row. Mr. Cornfoot was also captain of the swim team and graduated in 1953, receiving a BS degree. He also received a Masters of Education Degree in Educational Counseling in 1975 from the University of South Carolina.

Residing in Surfside Beach, Mr. Cornfoot was a retired USAF Major and was a member of Sheppard of the Sea Lutheran Church in Garden City. He was a part time program director for St. Leo College and the University of Albuquerque at Myrtle Beach Air Force Base from January 1975 to August 1976 when he became full time director for USC and Coastal Carolina until July 1992. Mr. Cornfoot then moved to the registrars office on the Coastal Campus with retirement in 1997. He continued to work part time at Coastal until May 2005.

Survivors include his loving and devoted wife of 62 years, Reba H. Cornfoot; daughter, Doris Lynn Cornfoot, daughter in law, Tanya Rae Sharp and

grandson, Alex Sharpe; sister in law, Shirley Cornfoot and family of Medesto, CA .

A Celebration of Life Service will be held at Sheppard of the Sea Lutheran Church, located at 2637 US-17 BUS, Murrells Inlet, SC on Tuesday May 29th. Visitation starts at 10am, service at 11am and Military graveside interment thereafter at Hillcrest Cemetery across from Coastal Carolina on Hwy 544.
