Bobi Summers, age 54, passed away Friday, August 29, 2014 at his residence.

Bobi was born in Orangeburg, SC, the son of David Summers of Conway and Isabel Douglas Brown of Winnsboro, SC.

Bobi loved life and people after his family. He worked in parts, then service, locally for East Coast Honda and formerly for Rick Hendrick Honda in West Columbia, SC. Bobi worked as a journeyman motorsports reporter with the radio show, "The Pit Stop" from 1995-1998. He also worked local events, from kart and drag boat races to a Little League World Series Tournament in Conway, SC. Bobi was the track announcer at Myrtle Beach Speedway for the past 16 years, making lifelong friendships locally and worldwide with much of the driver talent and fans that attended the races. While he was the track announcer he called more than 1700 events as of the 2013 season. This all began when Bobi was 12 years old when the scorekeeper/announcer was sick for a Little League Game.
