Mr Zometsky was a graduate of Laura Lamar High School, Homer City PA.

He attended Indiana State Teachers College of Pennsylvania, Mercy College in NY, and EMPIRE State College SUNY where he earned a degree in Business Administration/ Management. He was a lifetime learner at Coastal Carolina University.

Mr Zometsky was a member of the Professional Clubmakers Society, Elder Hostel Program, First Tee Program, Knights of Columbus (41 years), Boy Scouts of America, United States Golf Teachers Federation, American Legion, and the Elks Club of Myrtle Beach.

Mr Zometsky proudly served his country as a member of the United States Air Force.

While attending college he worked as an engineering technician for various employers including, Nuclear Materials working with

uranium and plutonium; GULF research, Westinghouse Nuclear Division on the NERVA program; and the University of Pittsburgh Engineering Department.

He was employed by IBM as Senior Engineering Manager (21years), Alcoa in San Diego California as Director of Operations. (4 years)

The culmination of his professional career was as the owner/operator of Golfware Company, a joint venture with his wife, Agnes. Mr Zometsky was licensed by the Golf Teachers Federation as a Class A Clubmaker.

He loved to travel the United States, enjoying many State Parks with his wife and family. Walter was an accomplished golfer, he played in a Pro-Am at Pebble Beach. On four occasions he had a hole in one.
