Obituary for William Hedgepath

CONWAY...William Fred "Bill" Hedgepath, Jr., 74, passed away peacefully after a brief illness on Monday, December 22, 2014. He was the eldest son of the late Reverend Fred and Adelaide Grey Hedgepath, born December 9, 1940, and was predeceased by his brother, James "Jimmy" C. Hedgepath. Bill Hedgepath was born in Greenwood, SC, and grew up in Columbia and Cheraw. He moved to Conway with his parents in his teens where he attended Conway High School and then later graduated from Augusta Military Academy in Staunton, Virginia. In the summers, he worked as a Myrtle Beach lifeguard. He received his bachelor's degree in 1965, from The University of Georgia. In his career, he managed Florida Screw and Bolt in Jacksonville, FL, and eventually returned to Conway to become its first independent real estate appraiser as owner of Hedgepath and Associates. He was active in the Conway community, served on several City boards and was named the Chamber of Commerce Man of the Year. He was a member of The Sertoma Club and Trinity United Methodist Church.

Survivors include his wife, Lynette Rogers Hedgepath, of Conway; two children, William "Jenks" Hedgepath and his wife, Kathryn, of Myrtle Beach; and Churchill Grey Bracken and her husband, Jeff, of Conway; a sister, Ann Chandler and her husband, Joe, of Murrells Inlet; many nieces and nephews and their children; and his faithful dog, Cocoa.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 AM Saturday at Trinity United Methodist Church in Conway which was founded by his father, Reverend Fred Hedgepath, Senior. The Reverend Dr. Sandra Stevens Poirer will be officiating. Burial will follow and those details will be announced at the visitation and the funeral.

The family will receive friends from 5:00 PM until 7:00 PM Friday at the funeral home.
